DOMAINE DE BROGLIE

Domaine De Broglie totals approximately 62 acres of land atop the southern peak of the Dundee Hills within the Dundee Hills AVA, a sub-appellation of Oregon's Willamette Valley. There are 42.2 total acres planted with 38.15 acres of Pinot Noir and 3.85 acres of Pinot Gris and Chardonnay. The site rises from about 670 feet above sea level to a peak of just over 870 feet. The soil at Domaine De Broglie is almost entirely Jory. Domaine De Broglie is proud to be a LIVE certified sustainable vineyard.
